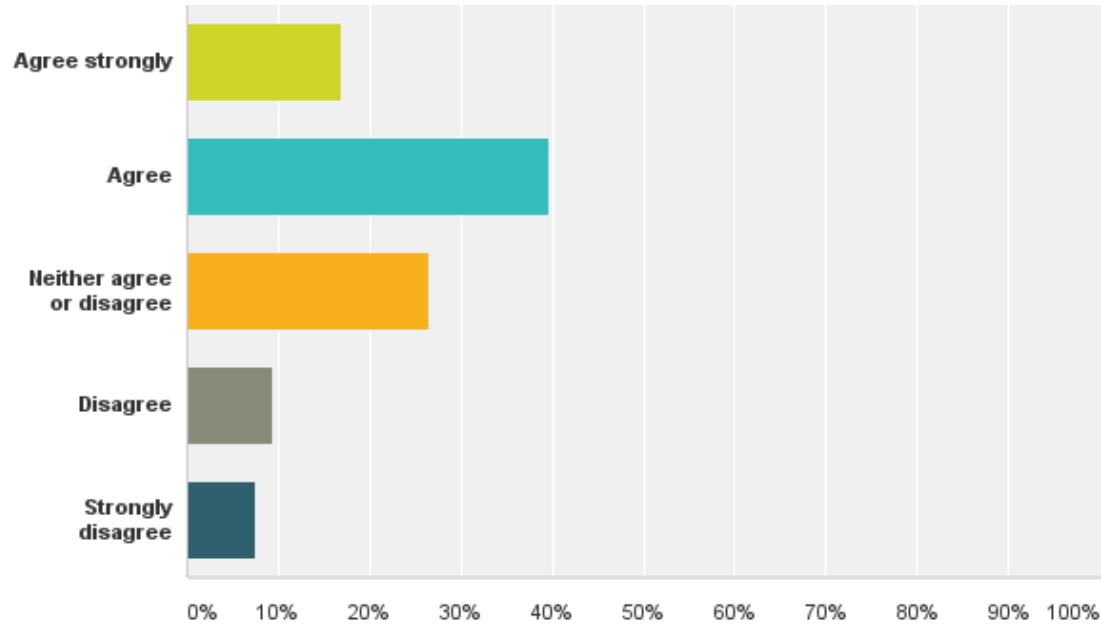

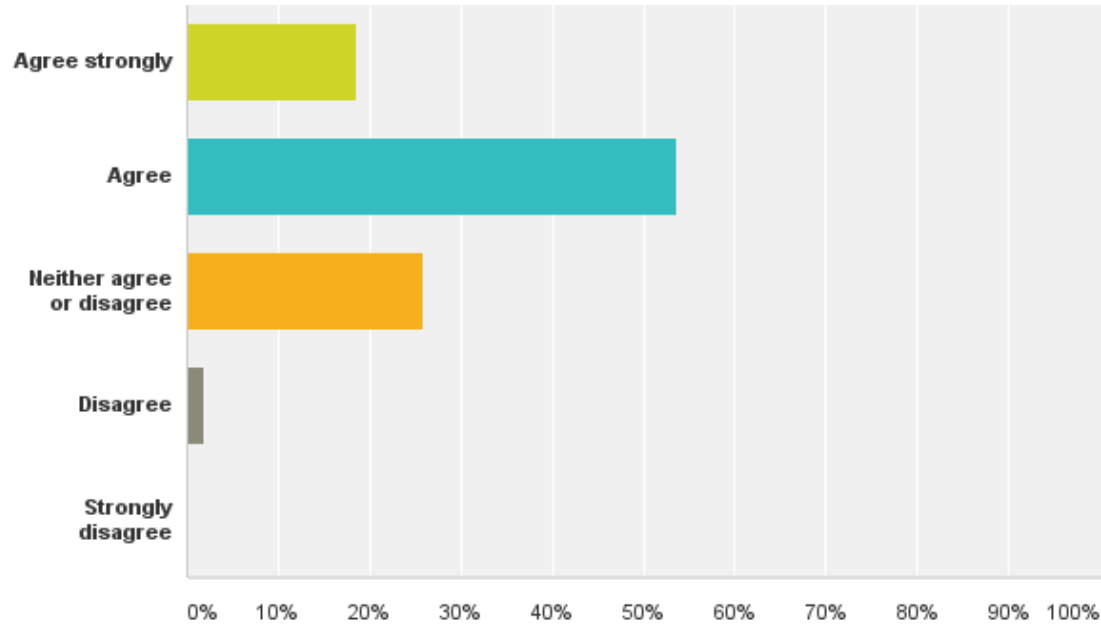
Q1: It is important for me that my child goes to a Church School

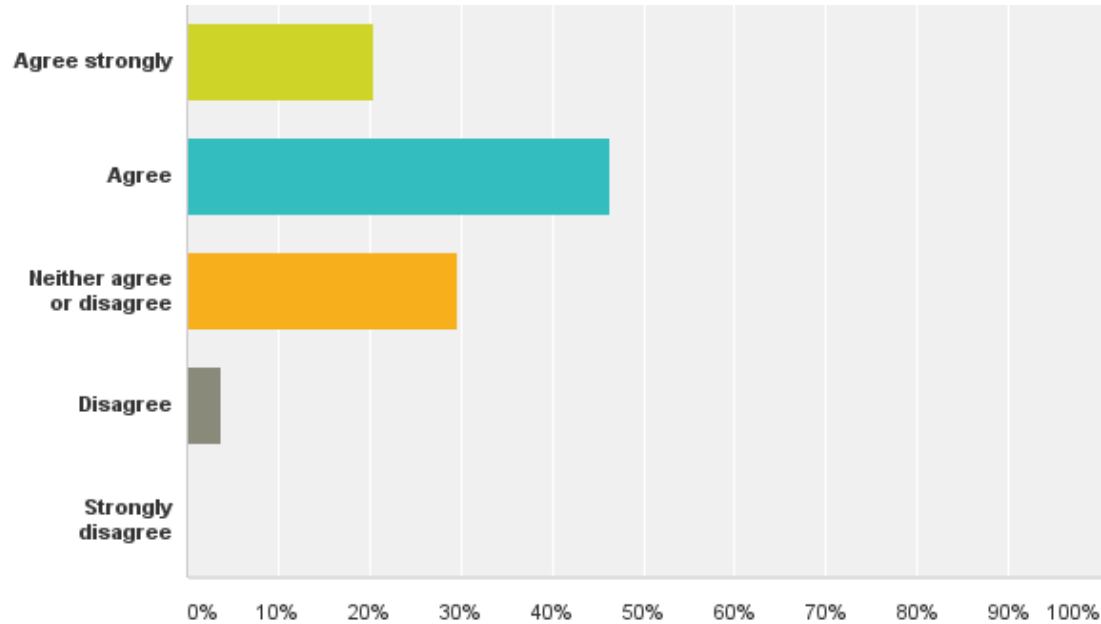
Q2: The school teaches Christian values that help my child's spiritual development

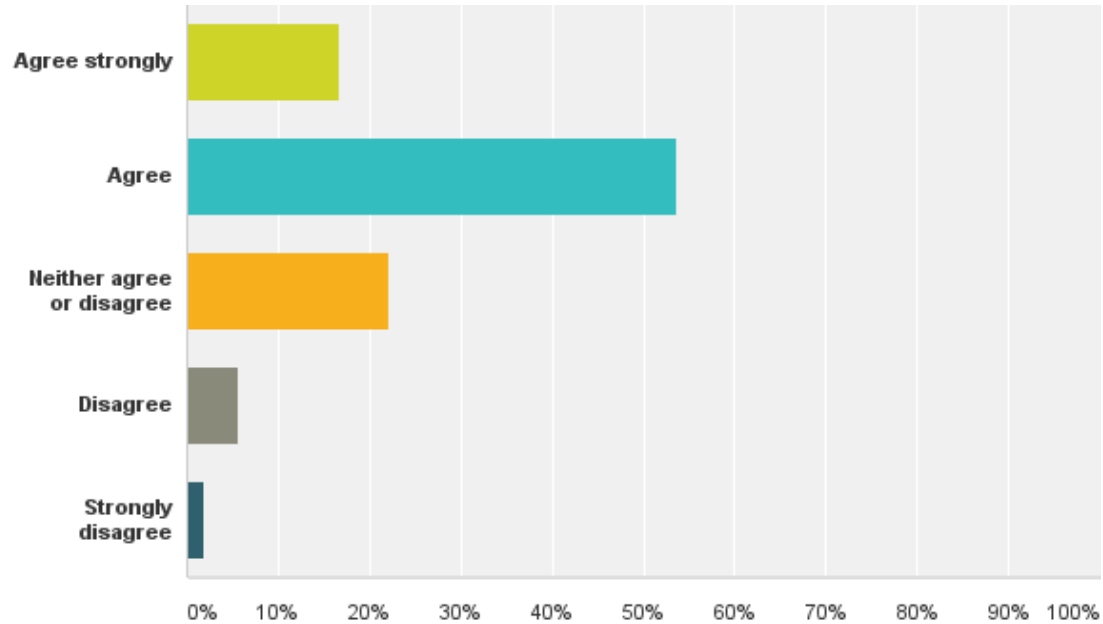
Q3: The school makes its Christian distinctiveness clear to parents

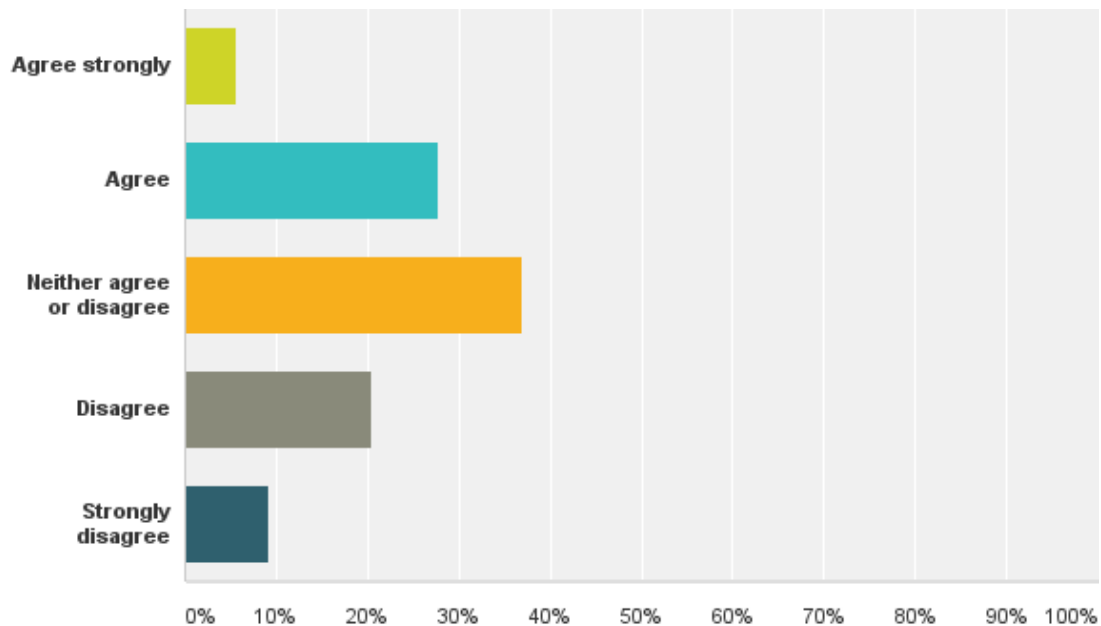
Q4: My child likes collective worship (assembly)

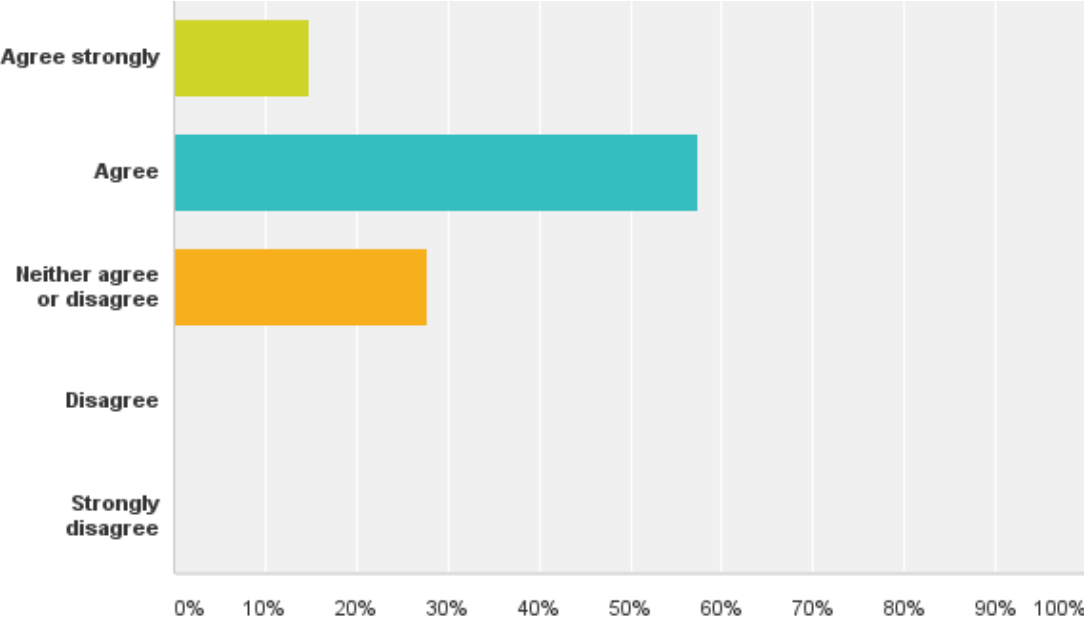

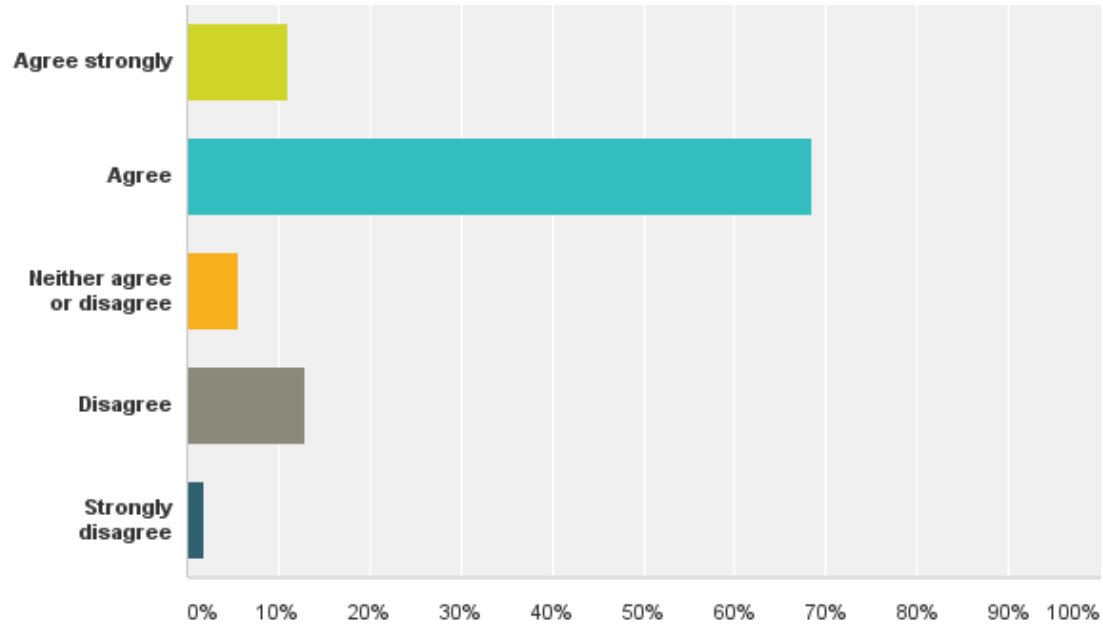

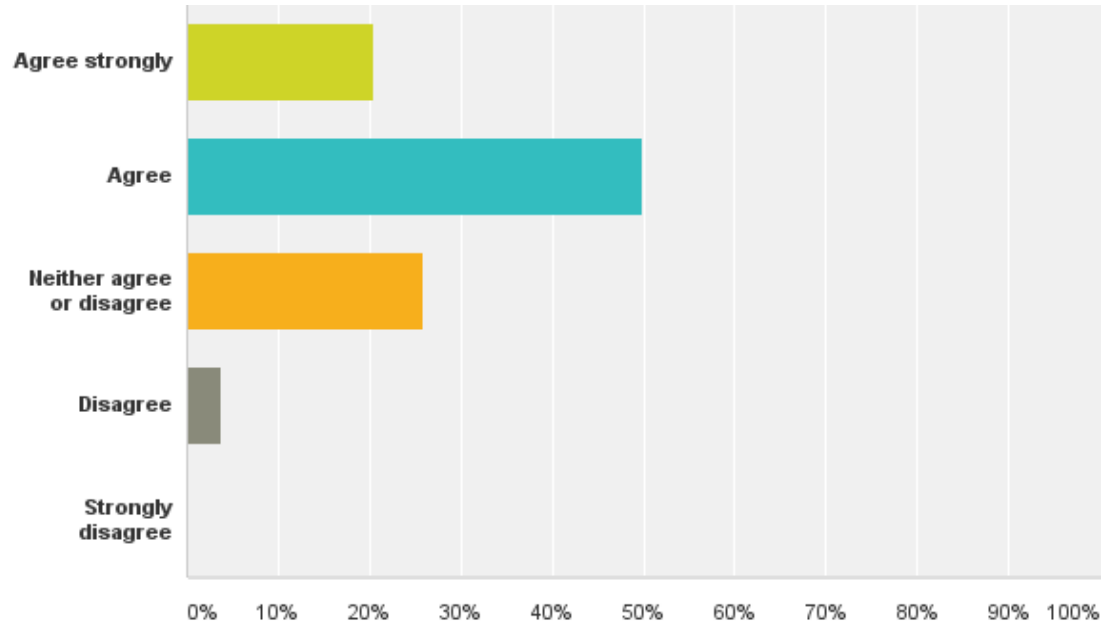

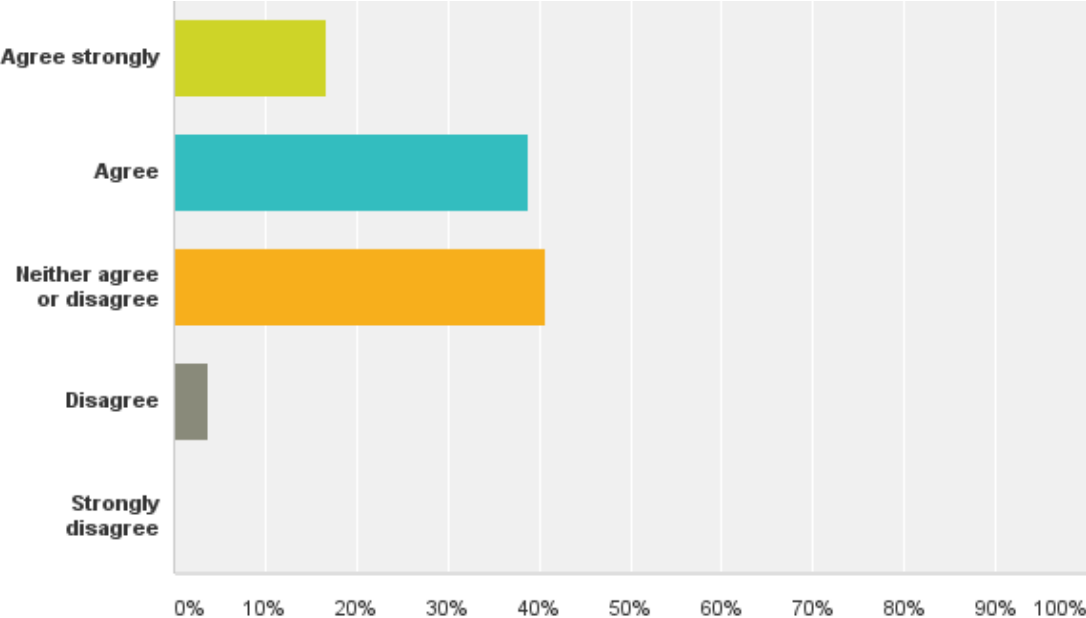
Q8: RE is well balanced and helps my child to understand others' religion and beliefs
