The Curriculum:

Literacy	Our literacy lessons this half term will be based on the book 'Bee and Me' by Alison Jay. The children will be writing diary recounts and newspaper articles before writing their own minibeast story. In grammar they will be learning to use the possessive apostrophe, past tense, present tense and subordinate conjunctions.
Maths	This half term, the children will be learning about fractions, time and measure. We will be developing their reasoning and arithmetic skills; and revising all the key skills: place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
