Home Learning

We have a home work club on a Friday lunchtime should your child need to use it. Home Learning (blue) books will be sent home with an information leaflet.

Home/School Contact

We ask that you stay in contact through our home/school contact books. We are available at the beginning of the day for emergencies and after school to discuss any issues.

Behaviour
