## **Curriculum**

Project: Tribal Tales

The children will be learning about prehistoric Britain and how our country has changed over many years. We will be incorporating lots of art and DT into our learning for this project.

In Numeracy, we will be developing our knowledge of number and place value, problem solving and measure.

In our Literacy unit this half term, we will be reading a Roald Dahl book called 'The Twits.' We will be using this to create our own short stories and play scripts.

## **Home Learning**

Please also ensure that your child practices their times table, as these are key to all the Maths concepts.

### Attendance
